WHEREAS, Columbiana County has set up the Columbiana County Coronavirus Relief Fund (B64) with the allocation received from the State of Ohio under HB481; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Columbiana County and other offices of county government have had substantial expenses which were necessary to respond to and combat the coronavirus health pandemic; and WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Columbiana County wishes to approve certain expenses for payment from

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF COLUMBIANA COUNTY, OHIO:

- 1. That the Board of Commissioners of Columbiana County, Ohio has reviewed the expenses attached hereto as Exhibit 2020-12-31-01-A
- 2.
