Treasurer Bryan Blakeman presented to the Board an oversight from his predecessor regarding appropriation to the postage line for 2021, stating he will need approximately \$25,000.00 to cover mailings for 2022. He stated his office is now going through a different IT service and will cost his office an additional \$5,000.00 and the office email will be an additional \$1,000.00. Commissioner Halleck stated to come see the Board in the fourth quarter next year if he comes up short after transferring funds.

Audrey Dimmerling was in attendance to thank the Board for their continued support of the 4-H program and to highlight some projects from 2021 for the County OSU Extension Office such as youth programs; numerous agriculture and natural resource programming; generation Rx for seniors for safe storage and disposal; going green to reduce or eliminate use of non-renewable resources and limit use of renewable resources.

Prosecutor Vito Abruzzino re-read the Proclamation honoring Susan Gregory for her retirement from the Prosecutor's Office as Susan was now in attendance.

Mr. Henry Bergfeld was in attendance on a fact-finding mission regarding the solar field project in Kensington. He questioned whether this was a done deal and Commissioner Weigle stated it is still going through the Ohio Power Sitting Board and Commissioner Halleck stated that Columbiana County is not 100% grandfathered. Mr. Bergfeld stated the general consensus of the area population are not for this project. Commissioner Halleck stated he would email materials he received regarding the solar projects.
