Mr. Jim Pusateri, Mr. Dan Thompson, Mr. Frank Ungaro and Mr. Tim O'Hara gave an update on the projects the County Airport would like to undertake this year as far as upgrades to the asphalt, a new fuel tank and a new hanger. They are applying for a grant with the Federal Aviation to rehabilitate partial parallel taxiway and are asking the Commissioners for a local match of \$31,014.00, if required. In turn, a new fuel tank is needed, as the old one can not be used with the new paving. There is no funding available through FAA and are asking the Commissioners for a 50% match (approximately \$50,000.00) for the expense of a 4000-gallon tank. Another project they want to undertake is a new 6-place individual hanger to accommodate the demand, again asking the Commissioners for a 50% match (approximately \$150,000.00) of the expense. The current hangers produce \$150.00 per month and the new hanger would be \$200.00 per month, which is their number one revenue source. Mr. Pusateri stated they are looking for a new board member with knowledge in aviation as Mr. Sayre will be resigning.

Commissioner Weigle stated they Board of Commissioners will take this information under advisement and will get in touch with them.
