## RE: INVESTMENT ADVISORY BOARD MEETING – TREASURER BLAKEMAN

The following members are present for the Board meeting:

Commissioner Halleck, Commissioner Paparodis, Commissioner Weigle and Treasurer Bryan Blakeman. Clerk of Courts Tony Dattilio – absent. Jim McCourt of Meeder also present.

Treasurer Blakeman opened the meeting by informing the Board he is required to report the interest earned and year to date we have seen a 25% increase over 2021. Jim McCourt of Meeder presented the Columbiana County Investment Strategy Update dated October 19, 2022 and briefed the committee members on the investments for the County. The federal rates have raised 300 basis points in six months, consistent with inflation and seeing a slow economy with raising interest rates is an indication of a recession. The liquid cash available and investments and terms limits were discussed as the board was assured the cash would be available to cover the ARPA expenses as needed.

Treasurer Blakeman thanked the Board for their time.

Pete Conkle presented the Columbiana SWCD newsletter and invited the Commissioners to the  $80^{th}$  Annual Meeting and Supervisor Election on November 3, 2022. The Election will be held at 6:00 p.m. at the New Alexander Christian Church with the meeting and dinner to follow at 7:00 p.m.

Commissioner Halleck adjourned the Commissioners regular meeting.
