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RE: CCDJFS – APPROVE LEASE AGREEMENT

Motion by Mr. Ginter, seconded by Mr. Halleck to; approve the 2026 Government Services Building Lease Agreement between the Board of County Commissioners and the CCDJFS. During the agreement period of February 1, 2026 – January 31, 2027, the CCDJFS agrees to pay an annual rental rate of \$482,123.00 which is payable in equal monthly installments of \$40,176.91 (or \$10.93 per square foot) on or about the 20<sup>th</sup> day of the month. During 2025, CCDJFS underpaid the Board of Commissioners by \$15,438.50 which CCDJFS proposes to add to the February 2026 lease payment.

Commissioner Ginter questioned how the payment is derived and Director Ketterman explained that Maximus uses square footage to determine the cost of rent.
